

- Long period of time. Multiple users?

- Easy navigation from dashboard
- Micro-rewards: completion rate, instant graphs and comparison

Indigenous Navigator Survey

The Indigenous Navigator offers a tool for thorough mapping of Indigenous peoples' rights at national and community level. The questionnaires can be completed either online or offline. The tool can be used without submitting data for review and will enable you to download a report in either case. To make data public, you will need to submit the questionnaire results for review, which can be done once all questions have been completed. If you wish to skip a question, you will be asked to provide a justification for the reviewer.



Data collection - questionnaire


- Guidance and information embedded in the questionnaire
- Possibility to leave notes and additional information on each answer.
- Review function to facilitate dialogue between respondent and reviewer, for quality assurance and security



Inclusive workflows


NO rigid organisational structures:

- Everybody can become a respondent and create an account
- The same respondent can fill several questionnaires
- A respondent can invite corespondents to assist in data collection
- Respondents can invite reviewers. Not mandatory, unless data is published.
- Data remains property of respondent; only published with Free, Prior Informed Consent
- An administrator validates no sensitive data is submitted, before publishing.



Final report – an output for the communities

- Demographics and maps are good.
 Nice with comparison with national legislation.
- Implementation gaps and focus on critical issues are good
- Less academia. More easy text, photos and graphs - less "conventions", indicator, attributes etc.
- Include data from national survey
- More narratives not all information fit into the questions.





Data Exploration

Three types of data exploration:

- Scores. Easy comparison and identification of keys issues
- Answers. Deeper exploration
- Framework. Relation between dimensions, conventions, (instruments/mechanism), indicator types and questions
