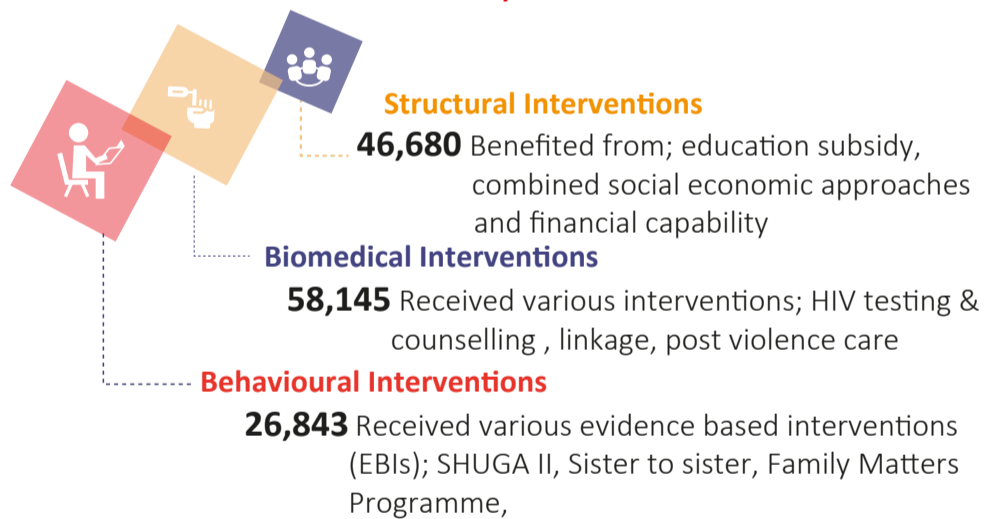

## Sexual Transmitted Infections (STI) screening and treatment

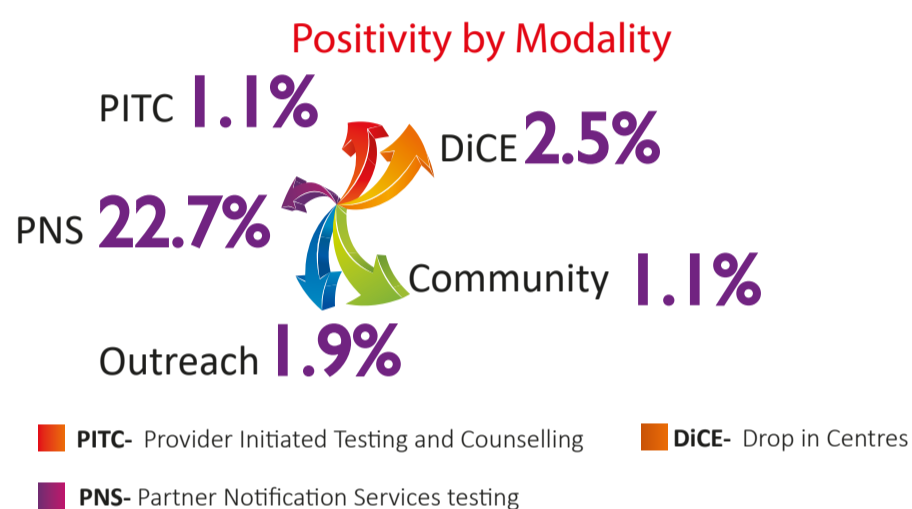

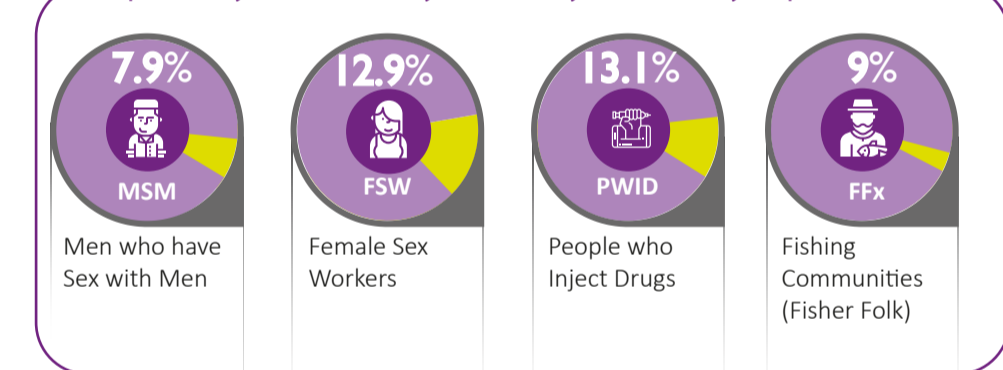
## HIV Testing Services

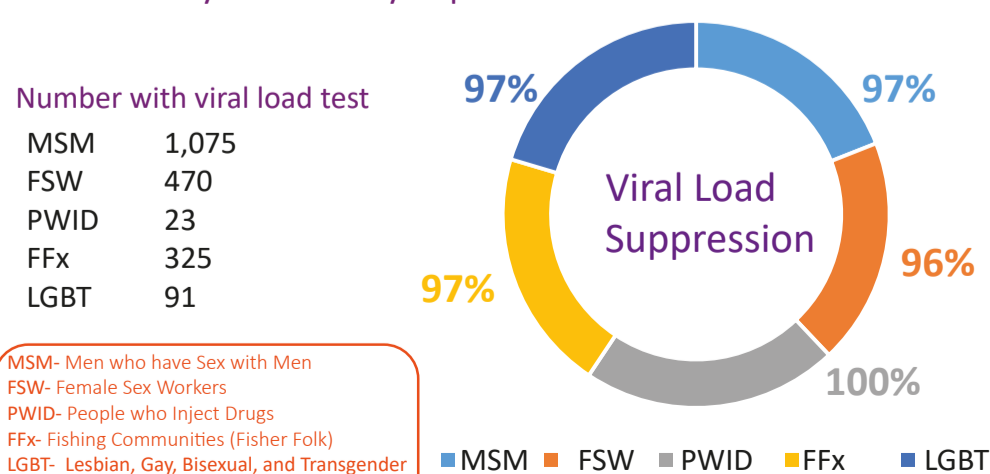

## Strengthening Community Health Systems

In the year 2018-2019 we worked with:

- 27 community units in 9 sub-counties in Nairobi, Kitui and Migori counties to improve community health strategies on maternal, newborn and child health.
- We offered training and technical assistance to partners implementing health projects in Nairobi, Migori and Baringo counties.
- Supported Machakos County in the roll-out of UHC towards establishing 250 community units by training 174 community health volunteers.
